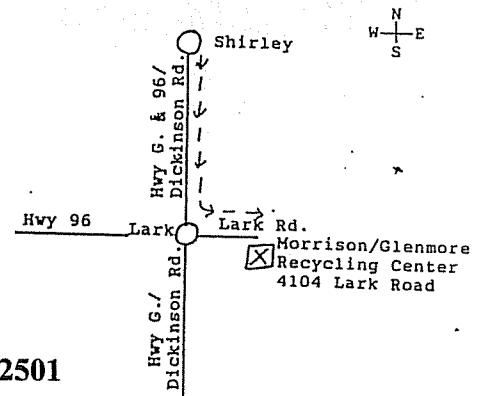

ITEMS THAT MUST BE RECYCLED:

- 1) **ALUMINUM CANS**
- 2) **CORRUGATED PAPER AND OTHER CONTAINER BOARD**-Bundle and securely tie all cardboard. Smaller pieces (cereal boxes, etc.) can be placed in paper bags-(double bagged works the best). Tie securely. No egg cartons, please.
- 3) **GLASS BOTTLES, JARS AND JUGS**-Please remove covers and wash. Do not break. **(METAL COVERS ARE RECYCLABLE-Add to the tin cans)**

REMINDER: WINDOW GLASS, DISHES AND OVEN WARE ARE NOT RECYCLABLE BECAUSE THEY ARE TEMPERED. THESE GO INTO THE SOLID WASTE.

- 4) **PLASTIC BOTTLES WITH NECKS**-We currently accept those marked #1 and #2. Clean and remove plastic covers. (Plastic covers are not recyclable-place into garbage) Oil or residue must be removed or the plastic is not recyclable.

PLEASE NOTE: GLASS AND PLASTIC CAN NOW BE MIXED. COLOR DOES NOT MATTER.

- 5) **MAGAZINES, NEWSPAPERS, JUNK MAIL AND OFFICE PAPER**-No longer need to be separated. Please place in brown paper bags (double bagged works the best). Tie securely.
- 6) **STEEL CANS**- Please wash, remove labels.
- 7) **USED TIRES**
- 8) **BATTERIES**
- 9) **WHITE GOODS** (Refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, etc.) **Scrap steel and tin** are also accepted.
- 10) **USED TIN FOIL, FOIL PANS**-Clean only
- 11) **USED OIL**

GRASS CLIPPINGS AND/OR BRUSH ARE NOT ACCEPTED. Each resident is responsible for disposing of these items.

STYROFOAM IS NOT ACCEPTED. Please clean and reuse these items as best as you can at home for other purposes. No Styrofoam egg cartons allowed either. However, you may return egg cartons to:

Send 40 cartons at a time (approx. 1.5#) by U.S. Priority Mail (accepts up to 2#)
You will be responsible for postage.

CHARGE TO DISPOSE APPLIANCE WITH FREON. \$20.00 charge to resident for each appliance dropped at the Recycling Center that contains (or previously contained) freon; refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers.

MORE RECYCLING NEWS YOU CAN USE...

TIRES. You are allowed 4 tires per household per year OR 8 tires per farm per year (large tires are rated for size) at no charge. Additional tire disposal will result in a charge depending on the size of the tire.

PAINT, SOLVENTS, PESTICIDES, INSECTICIDES, POISONS. These items are all hazardous waste and you must take them directly to the Brown County Household Hazardous Waste Facility. Paint delivered to the facility is mixed together with like product and given free to those in need. There is an exchange room where your delivered hazardous waste is offered to others for their use. You can also check out what they have on their shelves for your needs.

FLUORESCENT BULBS AND BALLAST: Cannot be disposed of in the landfill. Do not break. Bring to the Recycling Center or take directly to the Brown County Household Hazardous Waste Facility.

COMPUTERS: Not accepted at the Recycling Center. Donate to a local organization that may have a need or take to the Brown County Household Hazardous Waste Facility.

PLEASE TARP LOADS IN ROUTE AND/OR CONFINE MATERIALS TO THE INSIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE TO AVOID DEBRI IN DITCHES.
